Health & Safety

To maintain school security and ensure the safety of your children, all parents must enter the school via the front door and sign in at the school office. Please do not enter the building through the unit doors.

Improving Air Quality -**Engine Idling Campaign**

Children are more vulnerable to air pollution because they breathe 50% more air per pound of body weight than adults. Officers from Aberdeen City Council are soon to undertake patrols at schools where they will approach non-idling drivers and reward them with a small promotional item. This will hopefully reinforce the no idling message to drivers. Any driver who fails to turn off their engine when approached by officers may be issued with a £20 fixed penalty notice.
