Worried that a young person is at harm from a person online but don't know where to start intervening to help? We will be holding a LIVE Facebook chat on Wednesday March 21, 2018 from 7-9pm where officers and advisers who specialise in child protection will be on hand to answer any questions you might have on keeping young people safe while using the internet. We will also be posting advice and tips on the night to help young people be aware, stay alert and keep safe.
