

REPORTING AND COMMUNICATION WITH PARENTS/CARERS CALENDAR



TERM I

Staff and learners will spend this term building the foundations for positive relationships and developing a classroom routine. Towards the end of this term you will be invited to an Open Evening where your child will show you around their learning space. During this time you will also meet your child's teacher/s.

TERM 2

In this term you will receive an Interim Report. This report gives you a snapshot of your child's learning. This will be followed by a parent/carer consultation with the class teacher. Here the teacher will discuss the report, your child's progress and next steps.

TERM 3

During this term you will be invited to an Open Day. Here you are invited to visit your child's classroom. This is an opportunity for your child to show you their work and reflect upon the progress they have made. Learners are invited to give you a small tour of the school.

TERM 4

During this term, your child's Pupil Progress Report will be shared with you before a second parent/carer consultation. This is to discuss your child's report, their next steps and their transition to the next year.

During this term, the school calendar is busy with lots of opportunities to celebrate your child's progress. For the whole school there is Sports Day. Children in Primary 7 will have their Leaver's Ceremony and will be making visits to the academy as part of transition.

Our anti-preschool learners will be experiencing their Nursery Inductions. The preschool learners in our Nursery will be experiencing their Primary I Inductions.

From PI to P6, staff and learners will be focusing on the transition to the next stage of their academic career. Class letters will be released and your child will get to meet their teacher/s and class before the end of term.

LEARNING JOURNEYS

Your child's Digital Learning Journey will be shared once each term via Google Slide. Each term, it will include at least three pieces of the learner's work. This also provides an opportunity to discuss your child's termly targets, which are also included. The three pieces of work will be chosen from Literacy, Numeracy and one other area of the curriculum. A teacher comment will be included in the Learning Journey and parents are encouraged to add their own.
